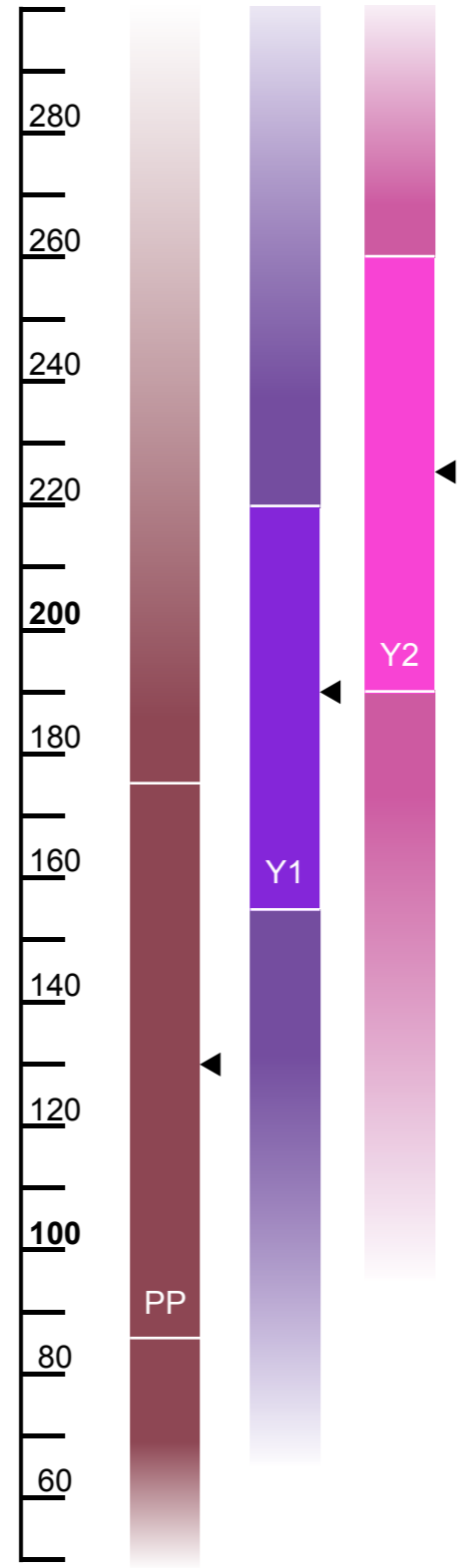


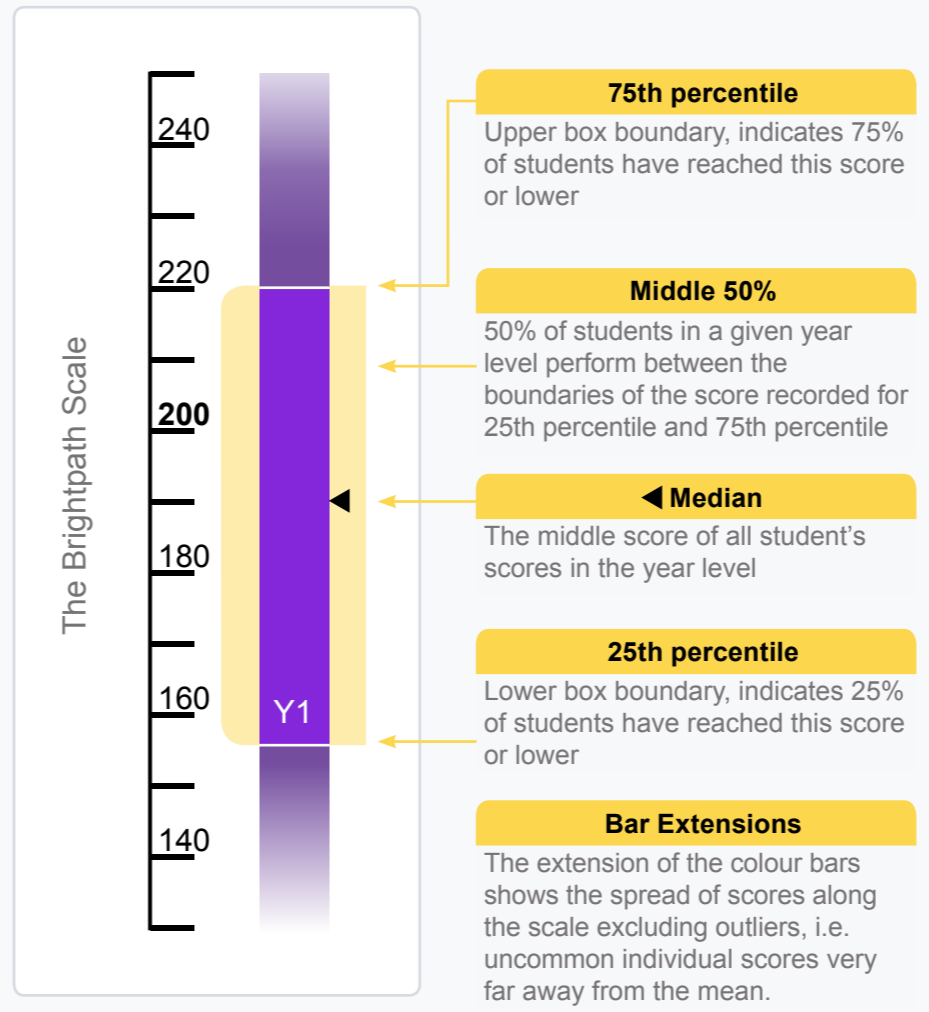
Recount Progressions – Lower Primary Year Scales

Descriptors and Performance Distributions

225 - 310	Writes a simple text which includes some related ideas. Their text can be readily interpreted by others.
170 - 250	Writes simple text in which they spell a small range of words correctly and write some basic sentences.
130 - 170	Writes a text such that some aspects can be decoded by the reader.
90 - 130	Writes recognisable letters.
70 - 90	Demonstrates elementary aspects of writing.
50 - 70	Demonstrates a rudimentary awareness of writing.



Interpreting the Display



The student performance distributions were derived based on data collected in 2021 on the Recount scale.

More about Brightpath Recount

The Brightpath assessments have been designed to provide teachers with detailed information about their students' progression in writing and what their students need to learn next.

How it works

1. Students complete the Brightpath writing assessments on paper, or online within the Brightpath software.
2. Teachers assess their students' work against calibrated exemplars.
3. Feedback about students' strength and weaknesses is immediate.

Teachers can view where their students are in their learning and what they need to learn next and they can immediately use this information to differentiate their teaching and inform their lesson plans.
